The U.K. reported 31% of workplace fatalities were construction-related in 2013.

Leading causes of worker deaths on construction sites were responsible for more than half (57.7%) of construction worker deaths in 2013. These "Fatal Four" were:

- Falls
- Struck by object
- Electrocution
